LIABILITY INSURANCE

The IACP requires each exhibiting company to provide proof of general liability insurance in an amount not less than \$1 million per occurrence. This is a safeguard measure in the event an accident occurs within your booth. The regular liability insurance carried for your day-to-day operations typically is sufficient. Check with your insurance company. They can issue a Certificate of Insurance for the event, usually free of charge.

IACP does not require that you send a copy of your Certificate of Insurance, however you must have the certificate on-site and provide a copy if asked.

Using a contractor to help with installation/dismantle? Non-official contractors also must comply with the above coverage provisions and provide a certificate of insurance to Show Management, Tarrie Chambers chambers@theiacp.org.
